Draw a picture of the Canada flag. Have your child colour it. Attach a straw to one end and wave it around. Listen to the sound it makes when it is flapping in the air.	RED & WHITE DAY Dress up in red and white. Drink red and white juice, eat red and white food. Bake a cake and celebrate. Sing "Happy Birthday" to Canada	Get out some of your pots and spoons and use them as drums. Make pattern sounds on your 'instruments'. Have your child repeat them back to you.	Have your child find the fireworks on this page. Say, "Fireworks", and have your child repeat you. Make the sound a firework makes together. Say, "A firework sounds like Boom, Crack, Bang', let's say it really loud."	Blow bubbles together. Encourage words like: "Bubble", "Pop", "Up", "Down." Dance around in the bubbles!!	Sing or hum the first line of "O Canada" together. Sing or hum other favourite songs. SUNDAY Read a book about Canada with your child. Go to the library if you don't have one at home.
