(The thumb becomes the head and the fingers the tail feathers.) | Bake a pumpkin pie together. Talk about the different smells and spices that are in the pie. After the pie is cooked, try it out! Talk about what the pie feels like in your mouth. | Visit a farmer's market with your child. Talk about all the different foods. Encourage your child to talk about where the food came from. |
